Paper Wasp



Did you know that in the fall, all wasps except for a few queens that go into hypernation die?

There are about 1100 species of paper wasps worldwide. Paper wasps construct a paper like nest with open combs for brood rearing. They secrete a chemical that repels ants and spread it around the base of the nest to protect their eggs.

Paper wasps feed on nectar and pollen and other insects like caterpillars, flies and beetle larva.

HABITAT

Paper Wasps like to build their nests in sheltered areas like the eaves of a house, tree branches, open pipes and along fences.

BEHAVIOR

Paper Wasps will generally only attack if they or their nest is threatened, they are also natural polinators and considered by gardeners to be benneficial.
