Brown Banded Cockroach



Male Brown Banded Cockroaches are fast flyers but the females can't fly.

Females deposit egg capsules in clusters on furniture, draperies, shelving, wall decorations and ceilings. The egg capsule usually contain 14-16 eggs and females can produce 10 to 20 capsules in her lifetime. They commonly eat starchy materials and are nocturnal. Both males and females can jump. If you find cockroaches high on the wall in a bedroom they are most likely Brown Banded Cockroaches.

DIET

The Brown Banded Cockroach eats anything organic including bodily fluids and decaying matter, they have even been found to eat glue, stamps, books and wallpaper.

HABITAT

Brown Banded Cockroaches only live indoors and unlike other species that like to live near food and water they are more likely to be found in your bedrooms and closets.

BEHAVIOR

Brown Banded Cockroaches live and lays its eggs in high places such as the upper sections of walls and ceilings.
